Discuss the **results** (after completing their experiment)

Give reason for the **reaction** that occurred

Give their **conclusion**

The children are familiar with all these important steps and are encouraged to refer to the helpful, fun science websites for kids and the science books in the library if they need assistance or inspiration!

We look forward to watching some exciting experiments being performed by our budding scientists!
