CLIMATE SURVEY FEEDBACK

The Board of Governors of Somerset House initiated a Climate Survey late last term in order to better understand the current sentiment of the school community. We believe that giving the school community a real opportunity to be heard is an important part of responsible governance.

We received 314 responses representing 307 families (102%), from a possible 572 parents (55%). We are satisfied with, and grateful for, the response rate which we have been told is well above the norm for such a process. As promised, we want to share with you the results of this survey, and you will find attached the graphics of the quantitative results.

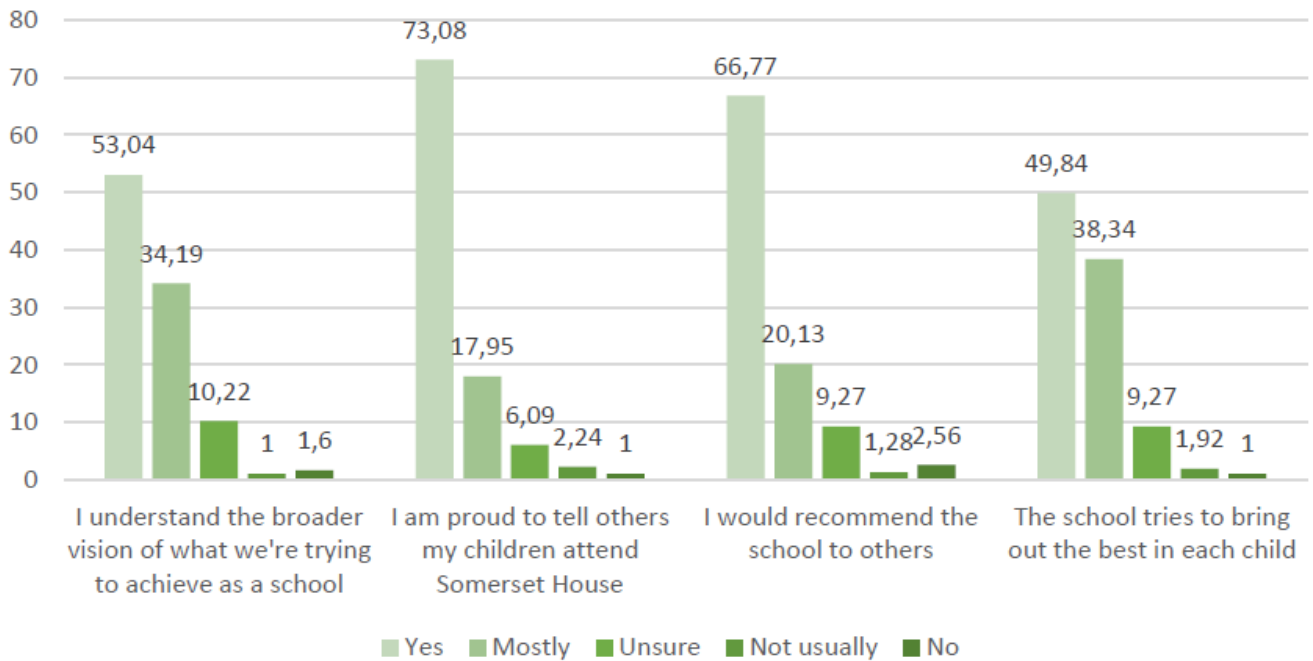
These results, together with those of the staff and pupils, have been studied by the Board and shared with the management of the school. They will be used in order to further enhance and foster a healthy school climate.

We thank you for your participation and assistance in this ongoing process of improvement.

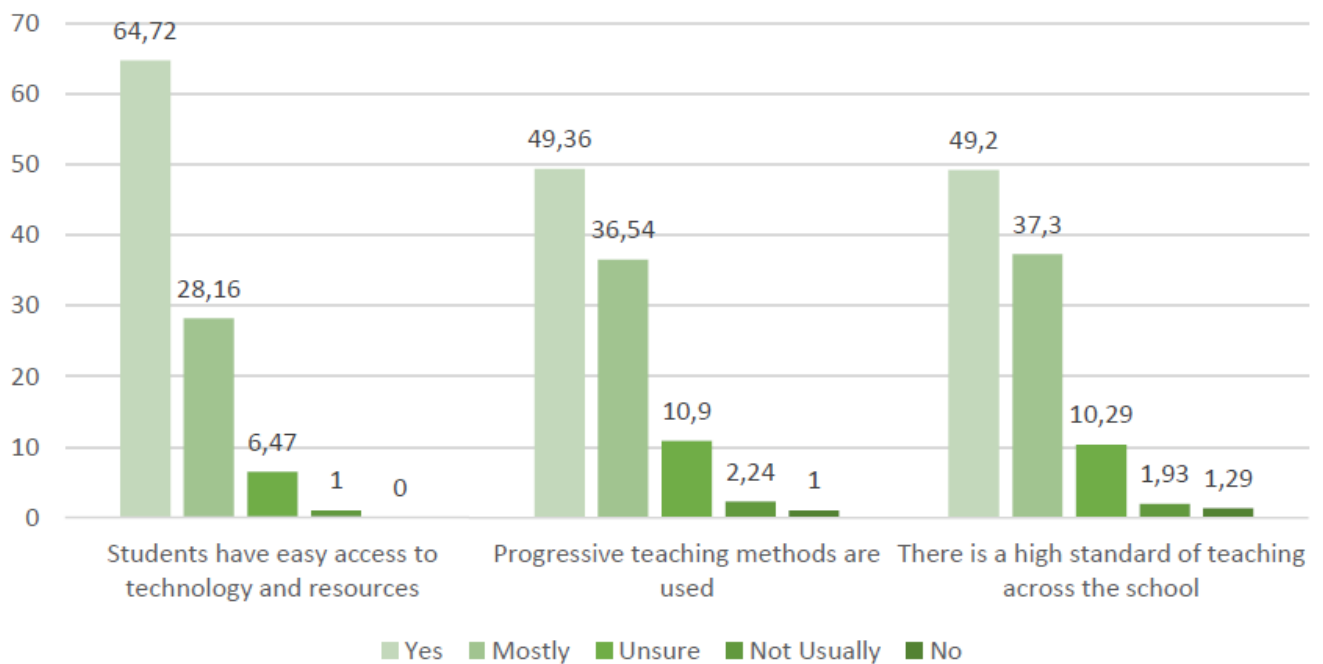

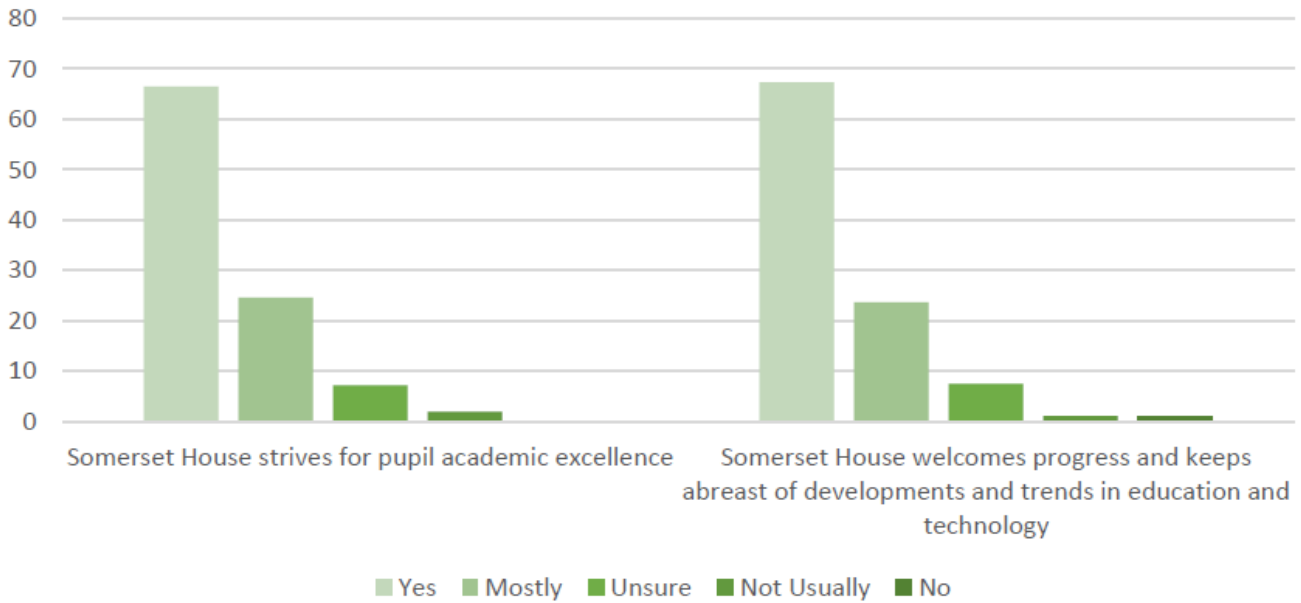
General Feelings towards the School - in percentages



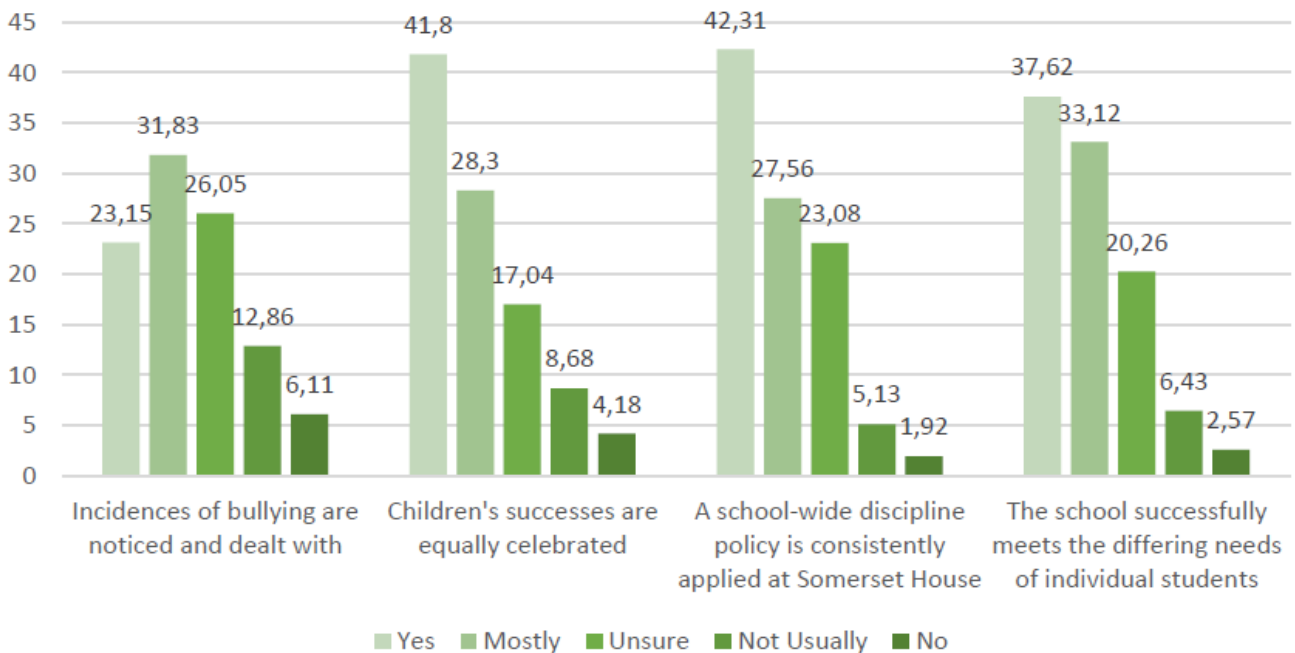
Technology and resources in the classroom - in percentages



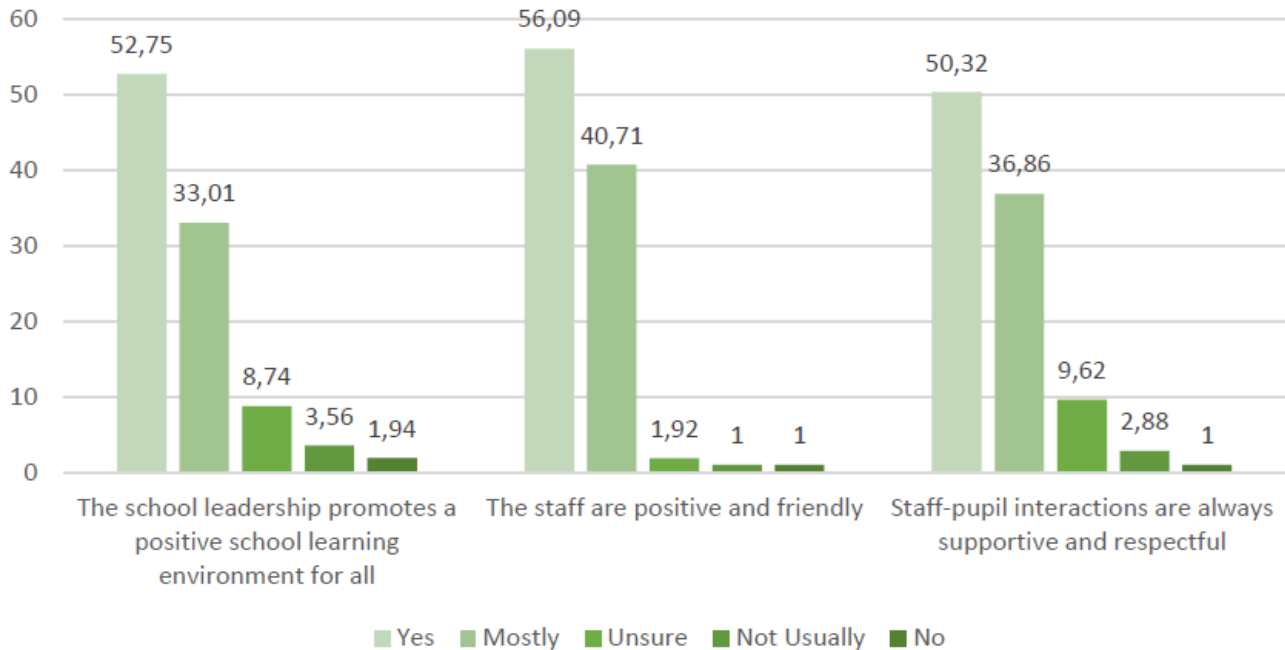
Technology and resources in the classroom continued - in percentages



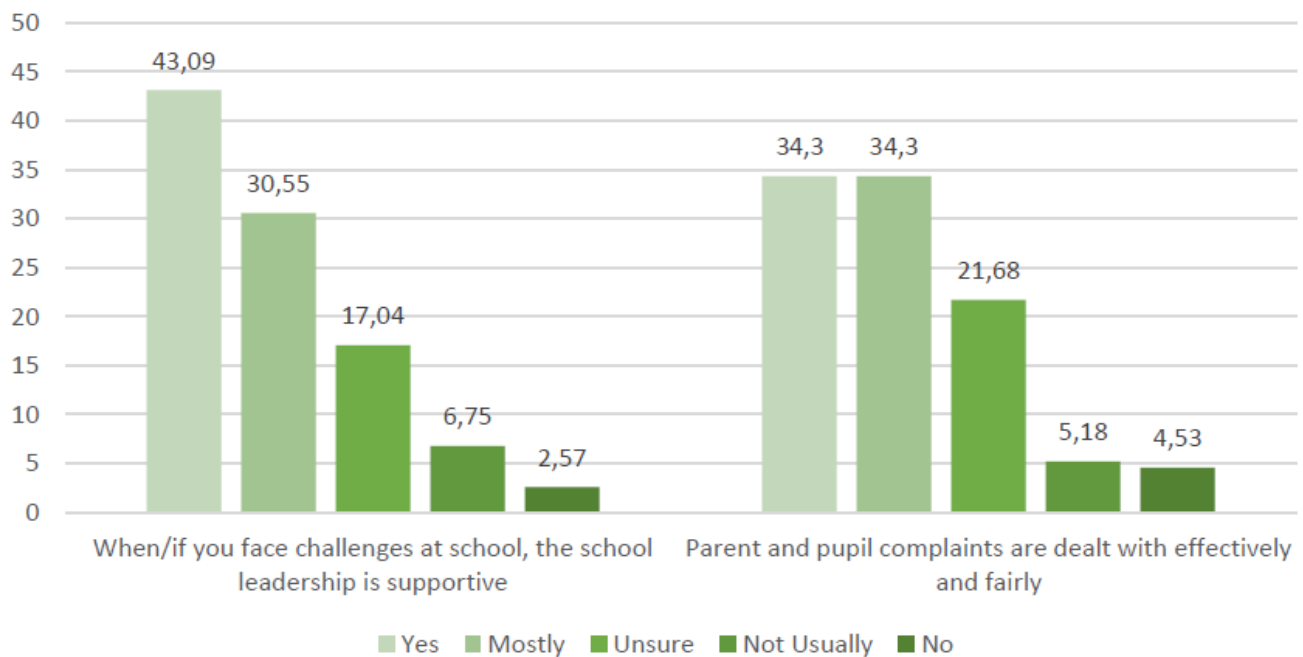
Bullying and Favouritism - in percentages



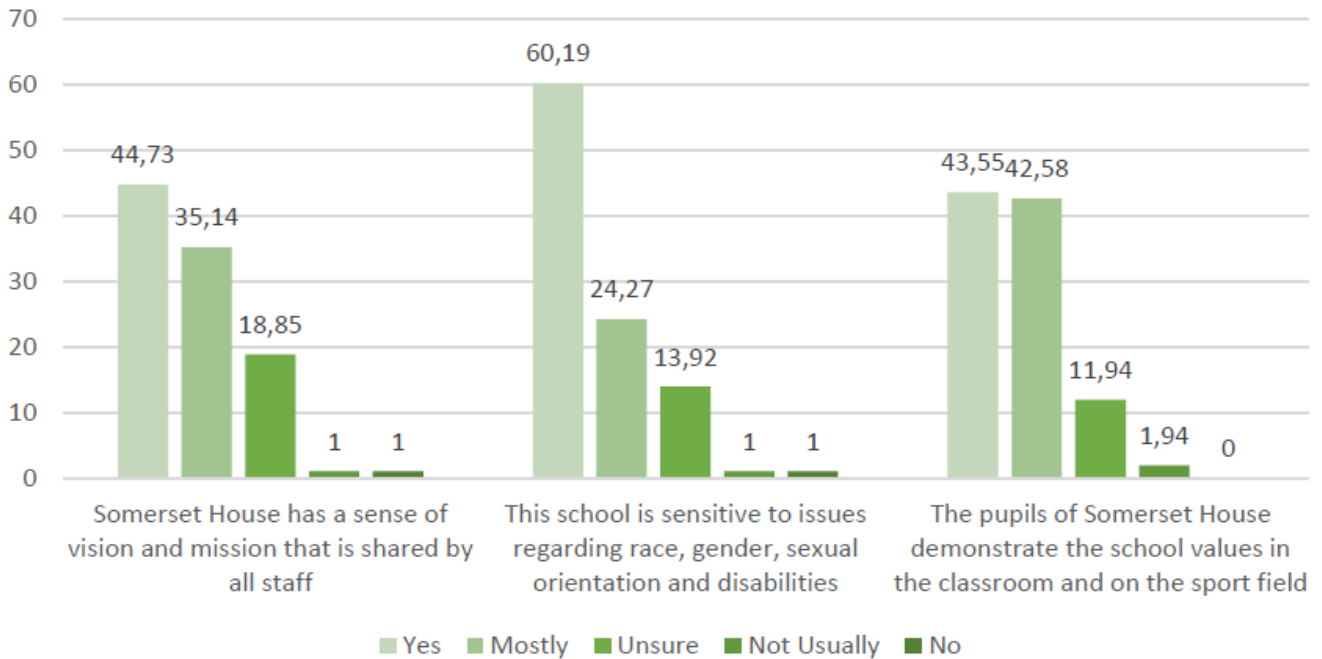
Leadership and Staff - in percentages
