For their presentations, we would like each child to choose an experiment (that has not been done in class already) to demonstrate to the class. They must show an understanding of the process:

Prepare their apparatus

Explain the procedure

Ask their audience for their predictions

Discuss the results (after completing their experiment)

Give reason for the reaction that occurred

Give their conclusion

The children are familiar with all these important steps and are encouraged to refer to the helpful, fun science websites for kids and the science books in the library if they need assistance or inspiration!

We look forward to watching some exciting experiments being performed by our budding scientists!
